YOUR LESSONS

20 lessons per week of General English designed to focus on building communication skills and confidence in using English inside and outside the classroom.

TEACHERS

Our friendly and professional teachers use communicative methods in a tightknit learning environment to help students learn quickly. All of our teachers are qualified English language teachers in order to ensure of a high-quality level of teaching. Our teachers will help students leave our course feeling more confident, able to speak to an audience and with a wider range of vocabulary and functional language.

WORKBOOKS

During their stay, students create a workbook that stands as a portfolio of their work to take home. It includes aims of the week, their targets reached, work based on their excursions and records of language learned.

THEME OF THE WEEK

Every week our lessons and the social programme are based around a theme. This theme allows students to learn useful language and skills, which they can then use in their end of week project. Students present their projects at the end of each week, which can be anything ranging from a presentation, a film, a town they have designed and much more. The projects allow them to work with their fellow students, from a whole range of countries, and practice a variety of leadership skills. Example themes include Food, Media and Fame, and the Environment.

GRADUATION

At the end of their stay, students make graduation hats and enjoy a small personalised graduation celebration. They receive a certificate showing their level and length of stay, plus a full report written by their teacher.

ENGLISH PLUS

We offer a wide range of English Plus sport and language options, which take place over 5 hours per week in the afternoons. Students can choose these options on arrival as a way of personalising their course.

All individual students under the age of 13 must travel as an Unaccompanied Minor and pay this fee.

Coaches and shared vehicles may be used for peak intake dates. For individuals and pairs, the following supplements apply.

Airport bus transfer: We are now able to offer a bus transfer service from certain airports.
